LOCH LOMOND & THE TROSSACHS NATIONAL PARK CORE PATHS PLAN REVIEW

The reporter has considered how best to treat the material submitted by Kilmarnock Community Council in its email of 4 May, and has decided to accept this as a further written submission in support of the community council's objection to core path proposal ADD26.
